**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-39**

**ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION AND ACCEPTANCE OF VOCA / SVAA GRANTS FROM THE OHIO ATTORNEY GENERAL AND AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR AND DIRECTOR OF LAW TO SIGN THE NECESSARY GRANT DOCUMENTS PERTAINING THERETO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Ohio Attorney General has funding available to provide a victim assistance program through the Federal Victims of Crimes Act (VOCA) and the State Victims Assistance Act (SVAA) program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Galion is requesting VOCA funding in the amount of \$16,318.07 and SVAA funding in the amount of \$1,417.76 to be used with a cash match of \$4,079.75 for the FY 2020 City of Galion Victims Assistance Program under the direction of the Galion City Director of Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GALION, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the submission of VOCA/SVAA grant applications are hereby authorized and approved for submission.

Section 2: That the Safety-Service Director and Director of Law be, and are hereby, authorized to execute any and all documents, respectively, as are necessary to apply for and accept a VOCA grant of Sixteen Thousand Three Hundred Eighteen and 07/100 Dollars (\$16,318.07) to be used with a cash match of Four Thousand Seventy-Nine and 75/100 Dollars (\$4,079.75).

Section 3: That the Safety-Service Director and Director of Law be, and are hereby, authorized to execute any and all documents, respectively, as are necessary to apply for and accept a SVAA grant of One Thousand Four Hundred Seventeen and 76/100 Dollars (\$1,417.76) to be used

with the aforementioned grant funds and match for the Galion Victims of Crimes Assistance Program.

Section 4: That in connection with said Application for the aforementioned funds, this Council understands and intends to provide funding for the City's local share in the amount of Four Thousand Seventy-Nine and 75/100 Dollars (\$4,079.75) for the grant described in Section 2 hereof.

Section 5: That this Ordinance shall be published in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Sections 731.21 and 731.22.

Section 6: That in order to preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Galion and its inhabitants, and in order to authorize the Safety-Service Director and the Director of Law to sign all documents necessary to apply for the grant funds pursuant to the deadline, this measure is determined to be an emergency Ordinance and shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law after its passage.

**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-40**

**ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2018-71 (PERMANENT 2019 APPROPRIATIONS) TRANSFERRING FUNDS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM UNAPPROPRIATED FUNDS VARIOUS FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GALION, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 2018-71 (Permanent 2019 Appropriations) passed December 11, 2018, be, and the same is hereby amended as delineated in the following sections:

Section 2: That Three Hundred Ten and 99/100 Dollars (\$310.99) be transferred from funds appropriated in 101-2010-52332- General Fund – Public Health – General Health / Contractual Services – Travel Expenses to 101-2010-52410 – General Fund – Public Health – General Health / Materials and Supplies – Operating Supplies.

Section 3: That Ten and 00/100 Dollars (\$10.00) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 101-8010-52610- General Fund – Debt Service – Bonds and Notes Principal / Debt Service – Principal Retirement.

Section 4: That Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$5,000.00) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 101-8020-52620- General Fund – Debt Service – Bonds and Notes Interest / Debt Service – Interest Expense.

Section 5: That Two Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$2,000.00) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 202-8020-52620- State Highway Fund – Debt Service – Bonds and Notes Interest / Debt Service – Interest Expense.

Section 6: That Six Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$6,000.00) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 603-8020-52620- Sewer Fund – Debt Service – Bonds and Notes Interest / Debt Service – Interest Expense.

Section 7: That Six Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$6,000.00) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 605-8020-52620- Electric Operating Fund – Debt Service – Bonds and Notes Interest / Debt Service – Interest Expense.

Section 8: That Two Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$2,000.00) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 608-6010-52610 Storm Water Fund – Debt Service – Bonds and Notes Principal / Debt Service – Principal Retirement.

Section 9: That this Ordinance shall be published in accordance with applicable Ohio Law.

Section 10: That in order to preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Galion and its inhabitants, and in order to make the appropriation adjustments in the Permanent 2019 appropriations without delay to meet pending obligations, this measure is determined to be an emergency Ordinance and shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law after its passage.
