ORDINANCE NO. 2019-41

ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ERROR MADE IN SECTION 8 OF ORDINANCE NO. 2019-40 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 8 of Ordinance No. 2019-40 was passed as follows:

That Two Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$2,000.00) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 608-6010-52610 Storm Water Fund – Debt Service – Bonds and Notes Principal / Debt Service – Principal Retirement.

and,

WHEREAS, an error was made in the account number that needs to be corrected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GALION, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Two Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$2,000.00) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 608-8010-52610 Storm Water Fund – Debt Service – Bonds and Notes Principal / Debt Service – Principal Retirement.

Section 2: That the effective date of this Ordinance shall be the same as Ordinance No. 2019-40 as passed on June 25, 2019.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall be published in accordance with applicable Ohio Law.

Section 4: That in order to preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Galion and its inhabitants, and in order to make the appropriation adjustments in the Permanent 2019 appropriations without delay to meet pending obligations, this measure is

determined to be an emergency Ordinance and shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law after its passage.

ORDINANCE 2019-43

ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO SELL PERSONAL PROPERTY ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF GALION TO ANOTHER OHIO CITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Galion has pieces of personal property that are not presently needed for municipal purposes, to wit:

6 (six) single phase 500 KVA step down transformers 7200 volts to 2400 volts

WHEREAS, the City has been contacted by another Ohio community in need of such items on an emergency basis and desirous of obtaining the same, and

WHEREAS, an Ohio municipality may sell personal property not presently needed for municipal purposes under power and authority granted to it by Section 3, Article XVIII of the Ohio Constitution, without bid, if authorized by ordinance, and

WHEREAS; City Council wishes to authorize this sale.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GALION, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the transformers referred to above are found to be not needed for municipal purposes.

Section 2: That the Safety-Service Director is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the afore-mentioned Ohio city to accomplish the sale of these items.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall be published in accordance with applicable Ohio Law.

Section 4: That as the sale of these items is tied to an emergency situation in another Ohio community, and the proceeds therefrom will benefit the City of Galion, and therefore is Ordinance No. 2019-43

tied to the health, safety, and welfare of the same, this resolution is to be considered an emergency measure necessary to provide for the public peace, safety, health, and/or welfare of the City, and as such will be in full force and effect immediately upon passage.
