ORDINANCE NO. 2019-74

ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2018-71 (PERMANENT 2019 APPROPRIATIONS) BY APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM UNAPPROPRIATED FUNDS AND TRANSFERRING FUNDS IN VARIOUS FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GALION, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 2018-71 (Permanent 2019 Appropriations) passed December 11, 2018, be, and the same is hereby amended as delineated in the following sections:

Section 2: That Forty-One Thousand Six Hundred and 58/100 Dollars (\$41,600.58) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 207-1020-52502- FEMA Fund – Security of Persons & Property-Fire Department / Capital Outlay - Furniture and Equipment.

Section 3: That Two Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$2,955.00) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 101-1020-52410- General Fund – Security of Persons & Property – Fire Department / Materials and Supplies – Operating Supplies.

Section 4: That Seven Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$7,000.00) be transferred from funds appropriated in 101-9001-52904- General Fund – Other Financing Uses – Transfers / Transfers – Transfer to Police / Fire to 207-0400-41429. (FEMA Fund)

Section 5: That this Ordinance shall be published in accordance with applicable Ohio Law.

Section 6: That in order to preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Galion and its inhabitants, and in order to make the appropriation adjustments in the Permanent 2019 appropriations without delay to meet pending obligations, this measure is determined to be an emergency Ordinance and shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law after its passage.

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-75

**ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN
ADVANCE TO THE FEMA FUND WITH SUCH
ADVANCE TO BE REPAID BEFORE YEAR END 2019,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, an advance is needed in the FEMA Fund in order to provide funds for payments until funds are received, and

WHEREAS, the General Fund has sufficient appropriated funds to advance necessary funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF GALION, STATE OF OHIO:**

Section 1: That Seventy-Two Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$72,600.00) be advanced to the FEMA Fund (207) from the General Fund (101), with such advance to be repaid before the end of calendar year 2019.

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be published in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Sections 731.21 and 731.22.

Section 3: That in order to preserve the public peace, health, and safety of the City of Galion and its citizens, and in order to meet anticipated obligations, this measure is determined to be an emergency Ordinance and shall take effect and be in force upon the earliest time allowed by law after its passage.

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX RATES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR
